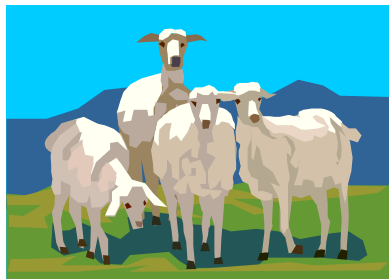

Little Lambs



St. Timothy's Little Lambs Nursery is glad to welcome all babies and children under 4 years of age.

We have wonderful caregivers who genuinely love working with babies and small children. They have been trained in all Safe Church Procedures.

Additionally the caregivers maintain the Nursery using the "cleanliness is next to Godliness" practice.

The caregivers introduce a new learning component monthly with a story, finger play, songs, prayers and poems. Parents can pick up a Parent Newsletter each month which provides information and other fun tips for parents. A CD of the songs is also available for a small fee.



General

1. The Little Lambs Nursery is open from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Sundays, even between services.
2. Children ages 4 years old and under are welcome in the Little Lambs Nursery.
3. No snacks are served in the Nursery. If you send a snack with your child please be aware we do not allow any peanut product in the Nursery.
4. Children must be signed in by a parent or other responsible adult.
5. Registration forms should be completed for each child in the Nursery.
6. Nursery bedding is changed after each use. Beds and toys are wiped down with a sterilized solution after each session.
7. If your child needs your attention, you will be contacted via your cell phone (please be sure your cell phone is on vibrate during the service).
8. For security and the protection of your child, he/she will only be released to those people listed on the registration form.
9. Children who are sick (fever, colored mucus from the nose, coughing, vomiting, skin rash, etc.) should not be in the Nursery.
10. A nursing area is provided for nursing mothers in the Nursery.

Diapering

1. Diaper bags, clothing and other personal items should be labeled with the child's full name.
2. Please include a change of clothing and an empty plastic bag in the diaper bag for wet or soiled clothing.
3. We suggest you bring your child dressed in comfortable loose-fitting clothing that will not restrict free movement.
4. Disposable diapers are preferred. We have a small supply and ask that you bring some in your child's size to restock the nursery from time to time.
